If you are a young person new to volunteering, Canoe England will recognise the hours you dedicate to volunteering through our Paddlesport Rewards Scheme.

Young Volunteers can register their hours in the Canoe England Logbook. Once you have achieved 10, 25 or 50 hours of volunteering you can send your logbook into us and in return you will receive a reward.

Silver Certificate
25hours

Gold Certificate

50hours



Your hours should be signed off by a mentor from a club, centre, or an event - anyone who can verify you have completed your hours.

What Roles can I take on in a Club or Centre?

For Canoe England, a volunteer is defined as *any person who gives their time, free of charge, to the sport in any role whether in a club, centre, committee or at an event.*

This could include volunteering as a coach, or official as well as behind the scenes or at an event.
